Yet, there are at least 16 Million <u>vacan</u>t homes in the United States.

There are also 2.64 Million people with 2nd Homes.

And.. there are 12-16 Million people with RVs.

The average pay gap between a CEO and their worker is 670 to 1.

Meanwhile, between 90 - 100% of minimum wage workers <u>can't afford rent</u> in the U.S.

In fact, 60% of the U.S. Population lives <u>paycheck to paycheck</u>.

Today, in the United States, there are more than 582,000 Homeless people.

We know that Homelesness <u>reduces one's</u> <u>Lifespan</u> by over 17 years.

We know Homeless folks experience <u>Hate</u> <u>Crimes</u> at a rate **10**x that of Housed folks.

And.. 74% of Abuse survivors stay with their Abuser because of finances.

In the U.S. today, 20 Million people can't afford to pay their Utility Bills.

Yet, 30% of grocery store food is thrown away. That's 16 Billiion tons of food..

In some areas Homelessness has risen as much as 70%.
